Guidelines for full paper submission

Frankfurt University of Applied Sciences, Frankfurt (Germany)

I. Formatting guidelines

To the largest possible extent, authors are invited to respect the following minimal guidelines.

Naming your file: Please use the following naming rule to facilitate the management of the received papers:

9EMESconf FullPaper Lastnamemainauthor-Lastname2ndauthor.doc/.pdf

Papers' length: full papers should not exceed 12,000 words, including references.

Characters' type: Arial 11. Use one line space between paragraphs.

Title styles: maximum 4 levels, numbered (1., 1.1., 1.1.1. and 1.1.1.1.).

Boxes, tables, graphs, figures must be numbered and titled.

Use **footnotes** (not endnotes). Characters' type for footnotes: Times New Roman 10. Use double **quotation marks** (") for dialogue and quoted material in the text. Single quotation marks (') are used for quotes within quotes.

Punctuation: Use no space before and a single space after: full points, commas, colons, semicolons, question mark or any other closing punctuation mark.

Example of comma (,), example of full point (.), example of colon (:), example of semicolon (;), example of question mark (?)









Reference system: The reference system adopted is the Harvard reference system: cite the authors' surname, the year of publication and the page reference immediately after the quoted material.

"In Europe, the concept made its first appearance in the early 1990s, at the very heart of the third sector, following an impetus that was first Italian, linked closely with the co- operative movement." (Defourny and Nyssens 2006: 4)

When the authors' surname is cited in the text, just cite the year of publication – and of course, if applicable, the page reference – immediately after the name.

According to Laville and Nyssens (2001), social capital is a fully fledged production factor within social enterprises since it is part of the production process and it improves it, mainly by reducing the transaction costs (...) and by reducing the production costs (...).

If you refer to two or more works by one author in the same year, distinguish them as 1988a, 1988b, etc. When they are more than two authors, cite the first author's surname, followed by "et al."

The authors conclude that "nearly all the organizations in the sample analyzed declared that they had more than one goal" (Campi et al. 2006: 45), which confirms the multiple- goal hypothesis.

When citing two references or more, use a semicolon.

To a large extent, these interpretations of the economic role of third sector organisations are compatible (Anheier and Ben-Ner 1997; Krashinsky 1997), and they have often been used jointly.

II. Submission and publication options

All full papers received by **27 July 2023** will be made available to the rest of presenting authors and conference participants. Should you not wish your paper to be distributed, please write to us at 9emesconf@emes.net. If you wish, you can add the mention "Do not quote without author's permission" on your paper.

Please note that only papers submitted by 27 July 2023 will be eligible for the both, EMES Best Paper Awards (two categories, researcher and PhD) and 1st UNTFSSE Knowledge Hub Awards (two categories, researcher and PhD). Those Awards will be handed in during the closing plenary on the last day of the conference.

If you do not provide your paper in time, please make sure to bring at least 15 copies to distribute to the session participants.

All full papers received by 20 November 2023 will be evaluated by members of the





Conference Scientific Committee with a view on making them available as <u>EMES Selected</u> <u>Conference Papers</u> on the EMES website.
