How to get to Liege by train?

The main train station in Liege is the **Liege-Guillemins** station. It is connected with the main Belgian cities (<http://www.belgianrail.be/en/Default.aspx>) and also with international traffic (<http://www.b-europe.co.uk/Travel>).

Most hotels are located whether nearby the Liege-Guillemins station or can easily be reached from the station by bus (nr 1 and 4) or by taxi.

How to get to Liege by plane?

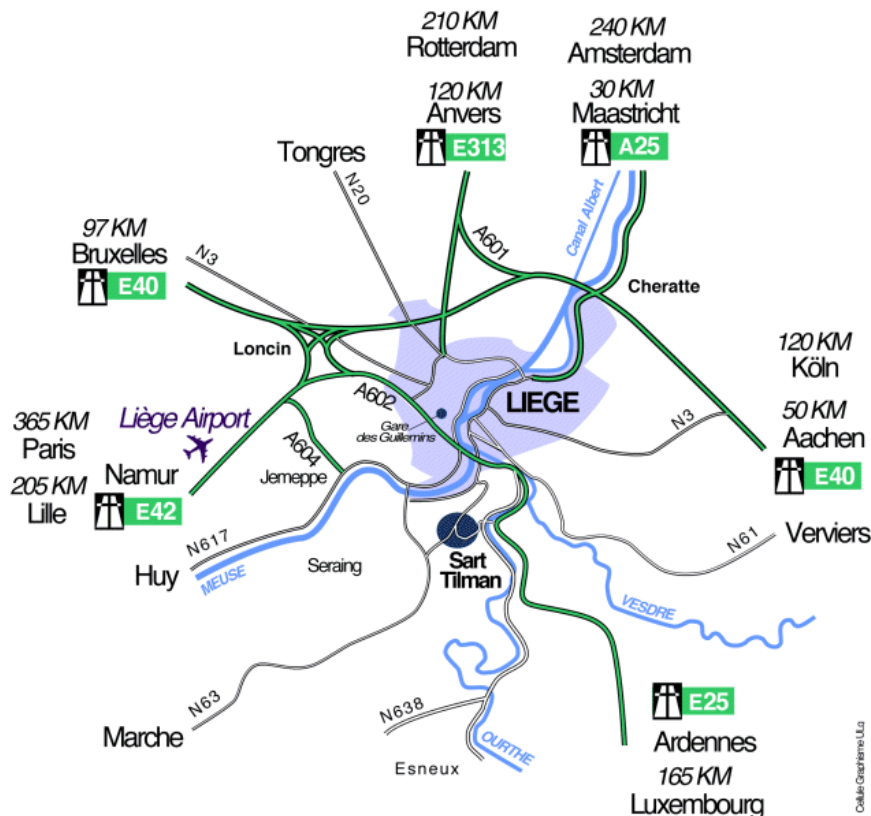
There is an airport in **Liege** (<http://www.liegeairport.com/en/home>) but it is covering only a limited number of destinations (Agadir, Alicante, Antalya, Malaga, Bodrum, Heraklion, Ibiza, Las Palmas, Cos, Palma de Mallorca, Marrakech, Rhodes and Tenerife).

There are three other airports nearby covering a wide array of destinations: Zaventem-Brussels airport, Charleroi-Brussels South and Maastricht. There are two train connections per hour with the Zaventem-Brussels airport, one per hour with the Charleroi-Brussels South airport, and one per hour with the Maastricht airport.

- Zaventem – **Brussels** airport is 1 hour away from Liege by train.

- Charleroi**-Brussels South is also 1 hour away from Liege by train.

How to get to Liege by car?

A very dense road and highway network (E40, E25, E42, E313) allows to get to Liege by car very easily. Below you will find a map of the highways around Liege

On the following map, the different key places have been encircled. The **HEC building** is the building where the opening plenary session of the conference will take place on July 1st, while the **emblem of the university** indicates the direction towards Sart-Tilman campus, where sessions will take place from July 2nd to 4th. Please note that transfers by bus from your hotel to Sart-Tilman campus will be organized.

The exact addresses of the venues are:

- HEC building (Monday)** - Rue Louvrex, 14 - Building N1, BE-4000, Liege
- Sart-Tilman campus (Tuesday through Thursday)** - Amphithéâtres de l'Europe, Boulevard du Rectorat, 13, Sart Tilman, B-4000, Liege
